

RainXchange™ System—Decorative Fountainscape Oswego, IL

Installed by Aquascape, Inc. in October, 2008

A decorative fountainscape was paired with the RainXchange™ System at a private home in Oswego, Illinois. Sixteen AquaBlox® were set into a rainwater storage basin in the backyard and a bubbling urn was set atop the reservoir to help aerate and cleanse the water for future use. The system holds up to 500 gallons and an AquaSurge™ 2000 pump was installed to keep the water running up through the urn.



AquaBlox® are placed into the excavated reservoir.



The decorative urn is connected to the plumbing system.



Plumbing from the Downspout Filter runs to the reservoir.



After plumbing is connected, decorative stone is added to the feature.



A Booster Pump is connected to the homeowner's garden hose. The Booster Pump creates enough water pressure to irrigate the surrounding landscape. Not having to tap into municipality water avoids having to adhere to a strict watering schedule. The bubbling urn provides an aesthetic feature to the landscape as opposed to an unsightly aboveground rainwater storage tank.
